T206 Introduction to Production and Design

The course objectives are to lay the foundations necessary for understanding and critiquing the production and design techniques used in television and film production. This foundation prepares students for production classes offered in the Department of Telecommunications. The first half of the courses looks at the formal structure of visual story telling, analyzing the structures of narrative and documentary films, sitcoms, dramas, and reality TV. The second half of the course examines the techniques of visual media, looking at the crafts of cinematography, lighting, editing, sound, and set design.

T283 Introduction to Production Techniques and Practices

The course objectives are to introduce the students to a hands-on concentration of the planning and production of video programs. The specific units include TV studio production, field shooting and non-linear editing. Content consists of applied activities within a conceptual framework.

T356 Multi-Camera TV Studio Production

The course focuses on television studio operations and production. Students will become proficient operating the cameras, audio board, lighting equipment, video switcher, character generator and other studio equipment. Students will write scripts, interpret & block scenes and direct individual and team projects.

T498 Dramatic Television Production

For this version of T498 students will produce the first season of an original web series entitled "Silence," which was written in the screenwriting class in the Fall Semester 2012. The intent of the class is to give students the opportunity to collaboratively work in roles similar to actual television production personnel, students will have one primary position that they will be expected to fulfill, such as Director or Script Supervisor, although additional duties may be required to insure a successful production.

T452 Single-Camera TV Studio Production (The Readers)

2013: This was a one-semester course, where students 'employed' (not in the fiscal sense) as many of the cross disciplines that a true Network sitcom would avail. Each student wrote original 3-4 minute comedy scripts, went through a casting process with actors and produced/shoot in the TV production studio; then polished the line cut, both visuals and sound, in post and 'broadcast' (post) their original web sitcom based on topical, political humor. This production was then made available online on Youtube.

T452 Short Film Class

This was a yearlong course; each student produced a short, original, narrative film approximately 12-15 minutes in length. In the first semester, the class started with the students' original scripts that were honed, read and work-shopped. The students' auditioned actors for their films then began the pre-production process on each film. By the end of the first semester, the students began shooting their projects. The second semester was structured so that three sets of crews were shooting at a time, showing dailies in class, showing cut footage in class, going through Foley, ADR and a music mix, ending with all of the student films being screened at I.U. Cinema, April 2014.

T435 Documentary Production

Each member of the class will act as producer for a 3 to 5 minute narrative story that may be chosen to air on a weekly public affairs program on WTIU, Indiana University's PBS station. This will give each member of the class the possibility of earning a broadcast credit as a producer. These short stories will help develop production teams and skills with production equipment during early class sessions. Evaluation of these projects will then help determine the final production assignments for a 30-minute documentary that will be produced and submitted to WTIU for possible broadcast. The subject/topic of the documentary will be chosen by the class and come from the documentary proposals developed in T431. We are looking for individuals with skills as producers, writers, videographers, editors, graphic artists, sound engineers, and web designers.

T452 Single-Camera TV Studio Production (Anim8ted))

2014: This was a one-semester course, where students 'employed' (not in the fiscal sense) as many of the cross disciplines that a true Network sitcom would avail. Each student wrote original 3-4 minute comedy scripts, went through a casting process with actors and produced/shoot in the TV production studio; then polished the line cut, both visuals and sound, in post and 'broadcast' (post) their original web sitcom based on topical, political humor. This production will be made available online on Youtube.
